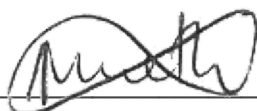

I, Nomakhosazana Meth, Minister of Employment and Labour, in terms of Section 30 of the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act (COID Act), 1993 (Act No. 130 of 1993 as amended), hereby notify all Compensation Fund Stakeholders that the Department of Employment and Labour has extended the license of the Rand Mutual Assurance Company Limited (RMA), to include all Class IV employers.

The RMA has a well-established track record in the mining industry since 1894 and proven capabilities in the management of claims for occupational injuries and diseases in terms of the COID Act. The Compensation Fund remains responsible for the compliance of the licensee with all the requirements of the COID Act.

The intention of this notice is to inform all Class IV employers registered with the Compensation Fund of the envisaged transfer effective from 1 April 2027. All new Class IV employers who are not currently registered with the Compensation Fund will be transferred to the RMA from date of registration.

The necessary engagements and communication of the applicable processes and procedures for the employer transfers will be communicated by the Compensation Fund.
